



## \*SCHOOL RULES\*

---

1. Smoking and taking of intoxicating substances is not allowed for any learner in and out of school. Such learners will not be allowed to be at school until such a time that they test negative of such additives. This therefore means that any learner found taking or smelling DAGGA or alcohol will not be allowed to be in the school premises. Repeated offenders may face suspensions or expulsion.

2. No learner is to be found in possession of drugs, materials used to take drugs, cigarettes lighters, matches or any related substances.
3. No screaming or high level noises are to be tolerated in the school during and after learning hours.
4. No dangerous weapons like knives, fire arms, screw drivers and sharp objects can be brought to school. No fighting at school or while in our school uniforms will be tolerated.
5. No learner can bring to school pornographic material
6. No sexual harassment will be tolerated in the school.
7. No kissing, sitting of each other, dressing of shorter skirts, proposing or asking each other or attending house parties will be tolerated. Those found guilty of such a misconduct face punitive measures ranging from suspension to expulsion.
8. No swearing or use of abusive language is allowed in the school or while in our school uniform.
9. Greeting of parents or other visitors who visit the school is compulsory and learners who fail to do so may be punishable by detention or any other means that the Principal or one delegated by him may find suitable.
10. NO CELLPHONES OR TABLETS or other related gadgets can be brought to school. If found in possession of such a gadget, it will be confiscated and a PENALTY of R250 will be paid by the parent or guardian before it can be handed back to the owner. If the learner becomes a repeat offender after a warning the learner will be suspended from school to attend counselling.

11. Learners are not allowed to loiter in the corridors or to move from one class to another borrowing items, visiting friends during learning hours. In that note it is a punishable misconduct not to be found in your class during learning hours. A subject register will be marked before the start of a lesson in every class.
12. LATE coming is regarded as a very serious misconduct of which if found in such a situation after three warnings, the learner will be asked to go for professional counselling that may take days before the learner is allowed to join others.

13. All learners are expected to do all their school work in time as advised by respective subject educators. Failure to have work updated at all times will lead to monitored detentions where learners will be required to update all their work.
14. It is a MUST to be in complete school uniform when at school. Please note that a learner who is not putting on a school blazer will be regarded as not in uniform at all. While in class the learner can be allowed to remove the blazer and hang it on the back of a chair but once the learner stands up to move from the sitting position, the blazer has to be worn.
15. Gambling is a misconduct that carries a suspension or expulsion.
